At ONVU Learning, we take security seriously. Recorded footage is only accessible to specific users who are added by an authorised Administrator from educational institutions. We process data for our customers, mainly schools, who are carrying out a public task as part of their statutory duty. We also have a legitimate interest in processing data while fulfilling a contract. Therefore, we recommend that our customers conduct a data protection impact assessment (DPIA) and engage in appropriate consultation with affected parties.
